


Living Things

Non-living Things Non-living things do not eat, grow, reproduce, and breathe.










PROBLEM SCALE

CATASTROPHE GET HELP RIGHT **EXAMPLES: HOUSE ON FIRE, BROKEN BONES** AWAY GROWN-UPS NEED HELP FROM GROWN-UPS **BIG PROBLEM** EXAMPLES: NO ONE COMES TO PICK YOU UP, YOU SAY: "I CAN GET MISS THE BUS HELP* KIDS NEED HELP FROM GROWN-UPS MEDIUM PROBLEM **EXAMPLES: FORGOT LUNCH OR SNACK AT HOME** SAY: "I CAN GET THROUGH THIS* KIDS NEED HELP FROM GROWN-UPS LITTLE PROBLEM EXAMPLES: MISSING A PUZZLE PIECE, FEELING TAKE A BIG BREATH ANNOYED SOLVE ON YOUR OWN OR KIDS HELPING KIDS **GLITCH** EXAMPLES: A FRIEND IS LATE, SOMEONE IS SAY: "IT'S OK. OH STANDING IN YOUR SPOT WELL."
