


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SCREENLESS SUGGESTIONS

Remote Learning Parent Tip: Acknowledging Positive Behavior: Why should I do it?

*Recognizing students for following rules, directives, directions, participating, etc is one of the most effective tools for managing, promoting, and correcting undesired behaviors

*Children respond far better typically to positive reinforcements than negative
